
# Staying Safe in our School



#### What is a lockdown?

#### Why do we have a lockdown?

We practise lockdowns so that we can stay safe if there is an emergency at our school.





### When are we practicing a lockdown?

We are practicing a lockdown on Thursday, before recess.






There will be an announcement on the PA to say there is a lockdown.





- We stay inside.
- We lock the classroom doors.
- We turn off our lights.
- We close our blinds.
- We move to a safe space.
- We stay quiet.



- The teacher will say where the safe space is.
- It could be on the floor, or under a desk.

If I am outside, I go inside, to the nearest classroom.

This might not be my own classroom.



If I am on the oval, the teachers might take us to the Undercover Area, or a classroom.



If I am in MiniLit, or MaqLit, or Bond Blocks, the education assistant may move me to the closest classroom.

This might not be my own classroom.



If I am in the library, I will stay there.

We will lock the library door, turn the lights out, pull the blinds down, and sit in a safe space.





### Who is there to help?

A teacher or education assistant will be with you to help and keep you safe.



If I am with another teacher, or education assistant, they will look after me.

#### The end of the lockdown

There will be an announcement to say that the lockdown is ended.
