- The winning faction with the highest points will be presented the shield at the end of the year 3-6 presentations.

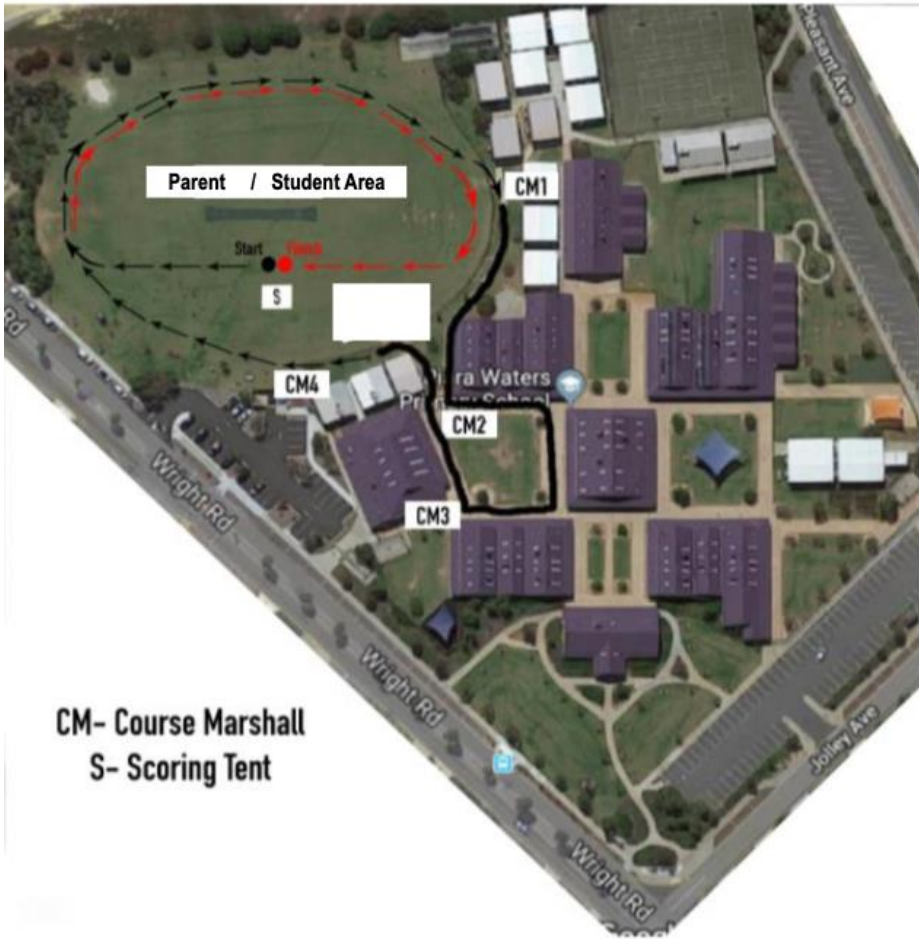


## Interschool Cross Country

Students are not able to access the coffee van.**

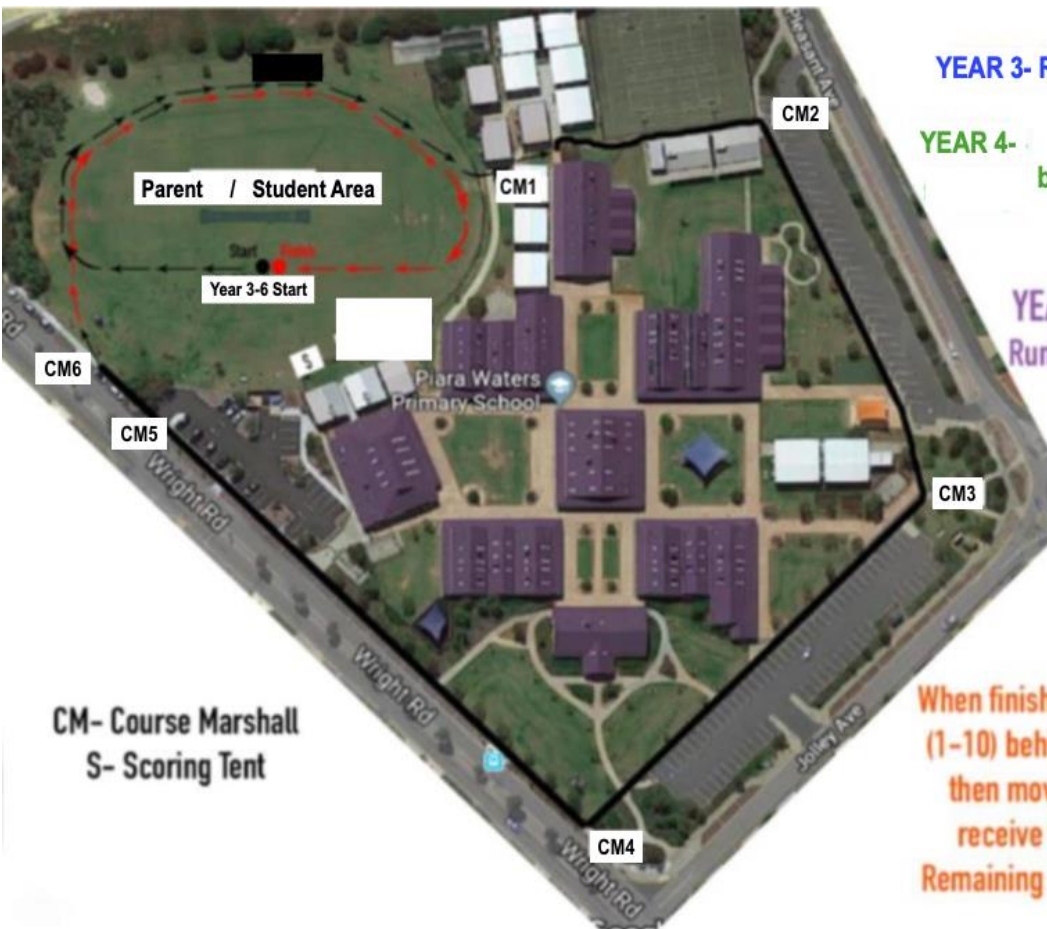




CM- Course Marshall
