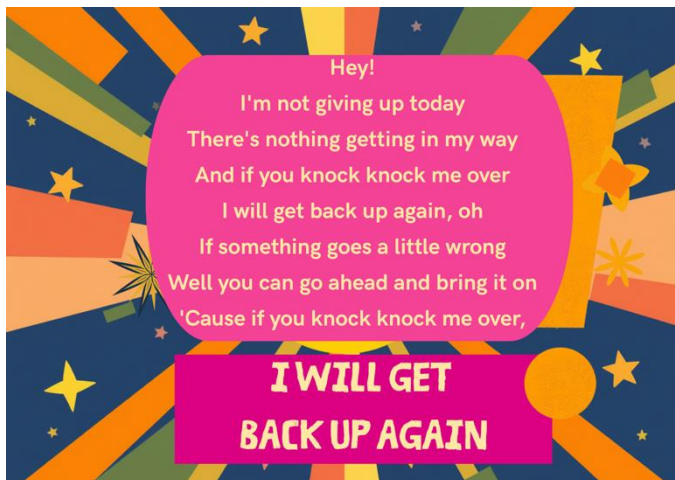


TERM 2 WEEK 9 UPDATE

GOLDEN RULES CLARIFICATION

Our students have been revisiting our Golden Rules to ensure that everyone is aware of them. Our rules are in place to keep our school in good order and everyone safe.

There are a few rules that students sometimes forget, and this makes our school environment unsafe. Can you please support us to ensure

- We always walk (not ride) our scooters and bikes inside the school gates.
- We only walk on the concrete paths (not run, even when playing chasey or tag)
- Only one person is on the trampoline at once (or two people on the big trampoline near the 50s classrooms). This includes after school.
- Students can stay and play on school playgrounds after school until 2:45 pm **if the child's parent provides direct supervision.**

Students who live within the school's local intake area (or those with siblings currently enrolled at PWPS in the 2026 PWPS local intake area, but the new local intake area of Aspiri or Piara Waters West PS in 2027) are guaranteed a place, but you still need to re-enrol.
- Current Pre-Primary to Year 5 students do not need to re-enrol for 2027 unless moving schools.

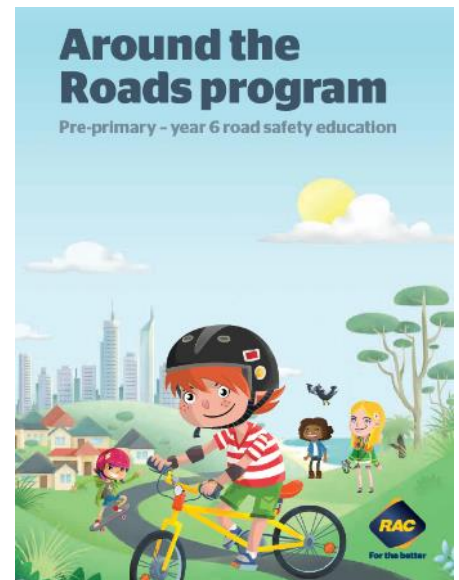
