

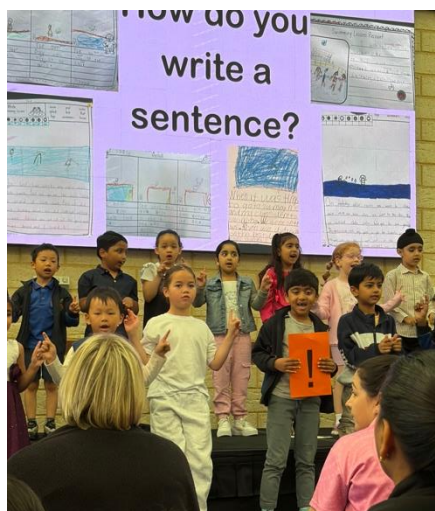
TERM 3, WEEK 10 UPDATE
