DRESS UP DAY AND PARADE

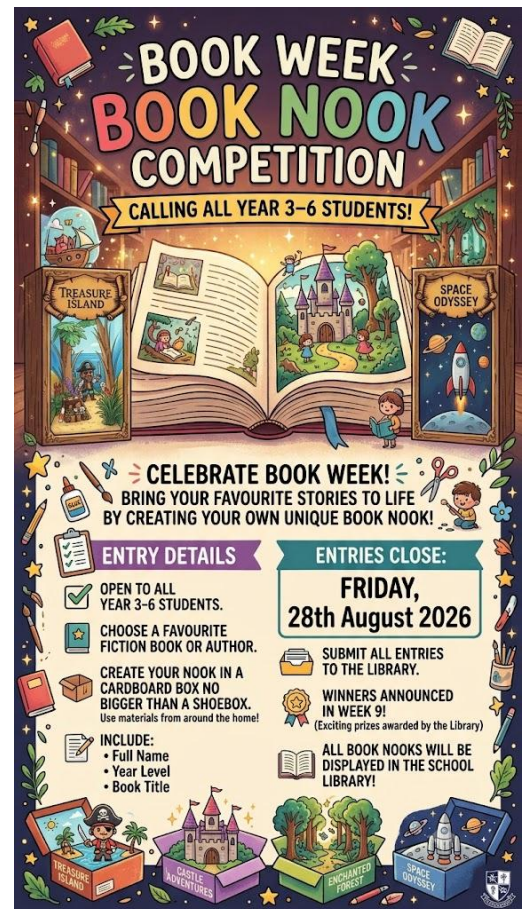
On **Friday, 28 August**, all students and staff from Kindy B to Year 6 are invited to come to school dressed as a character from a book or as a book title.

SCIENCE WEEK

Science week is here!



Throughout the week, the Science Team will be running a range of exciting science activities in their classes as we celebrate Science Week. There will also be fun lunchtime activities happening each day for students to enjoy.

This week, all Year 6 students will also begin working on their Science Expo projects as part of National Science Week. In keeping with the National Science Week focus on encouraging an interest in science and scientific inquiry, students will begin by brainstorming and researching ideas they may like to explore for their projects.

Working mostly in pairs, students will continue developing their projects during Science lessons each week as they work towards the Science Expo in Week 7 of Term 4.

PRE-PRIMARY INTERM SWIMMING LESSONS COMMENCE

Swimming lessons commence for Pre-Primary students at State Swim, Canning Vale. Students will need goggles for their lessons and a towel or dressing gown (or large shirt) to wear on the journey to and from the pool.

Students are welcome to wear their bathers to school underneath their school uniforms. They will have an opportunity to get changed and ready to swim before boarding the bus.

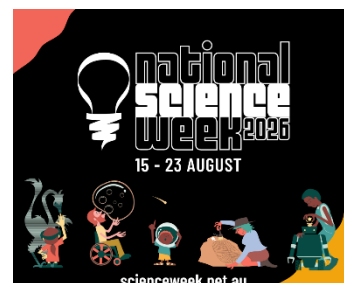

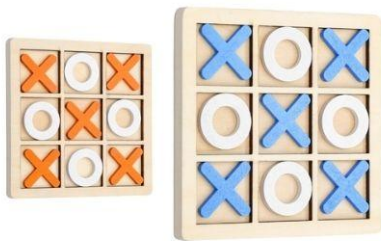
