Understanding the Social Media Ban

As a school, we continue to scrutinise and reduce the amount of "screen time" our students have in

classrooms. The phasing out of our previous BYOD program was one of these steps to ensure a greater focus on handwriting and communication and less on a device.

As you would be aware, the federal government has legislated that from December 10 people under the age of 16 will not be able to sign up for social media accounts. To do so will be against the law. Social media platforms will be expected to "detect and deactivate or remove" accounts from existing underage users.

We encourage families to understand these important changes and put steps in place early.


