The latest Scholastic Book Club orders have arrived and will be distributed to students today.

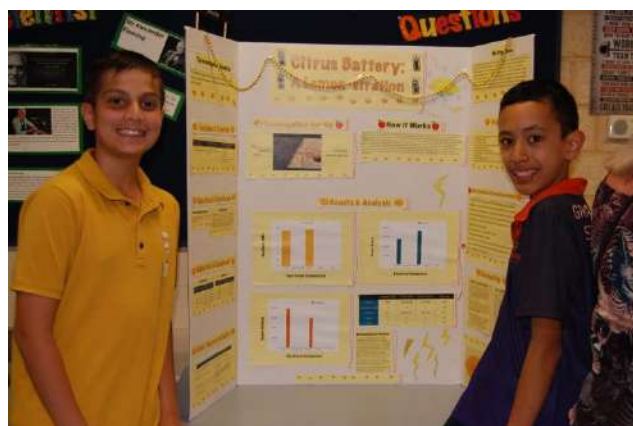
SCIENCE FAIR – ROOM 19 PRESENTING

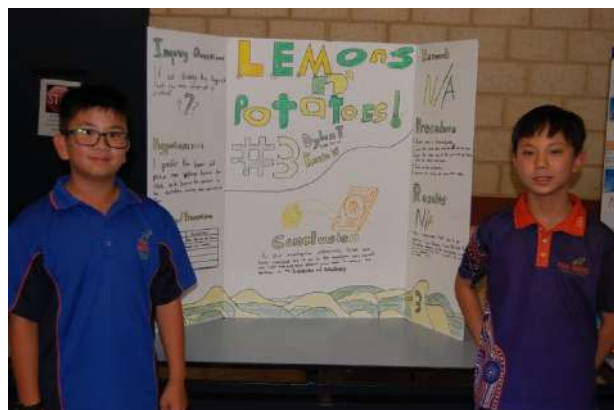

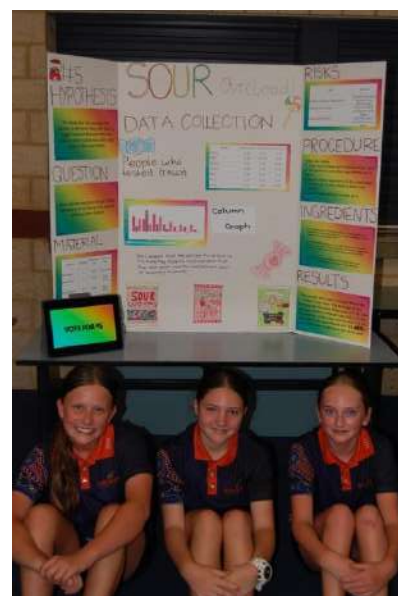

- Everyone will vote for their favourite projects. The project with the highest votes will win the Community Choice award, which will be presented at the finals showcase on Friday.

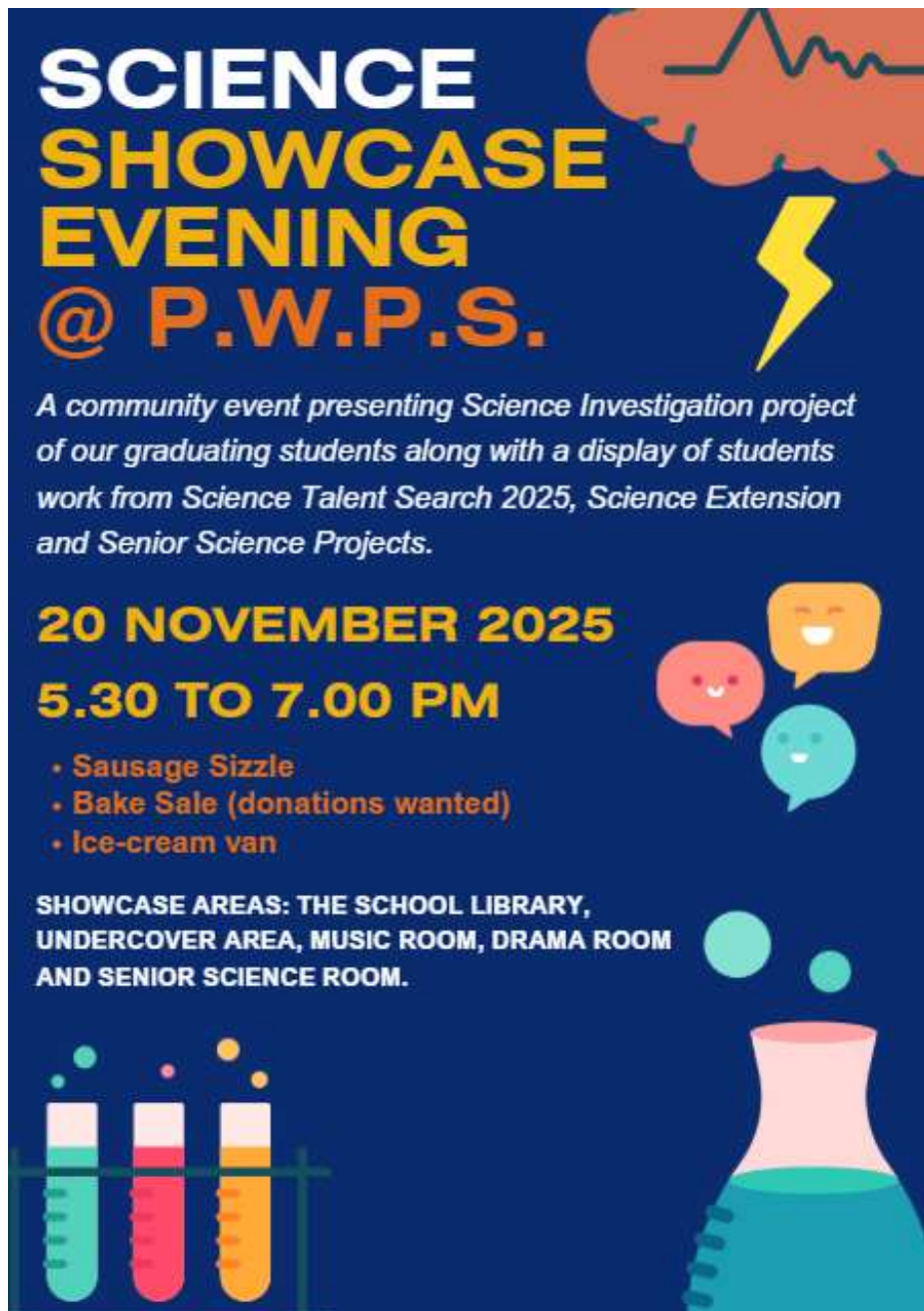
SAUSAGE SIZZLE AND BAKE SALE
