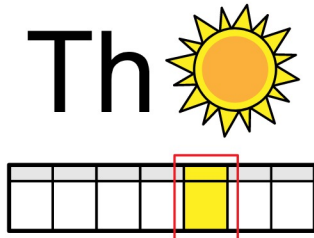
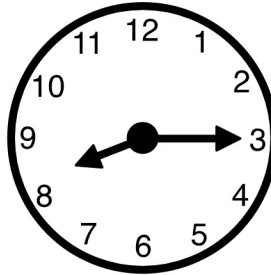


Year 3 Excursion to Brownes Dairy and Bunnings Room 33 and 34



On Thursday, I will visit Brownes Dairy and Bunnings with students from my class. There will be other Year 3 students too.



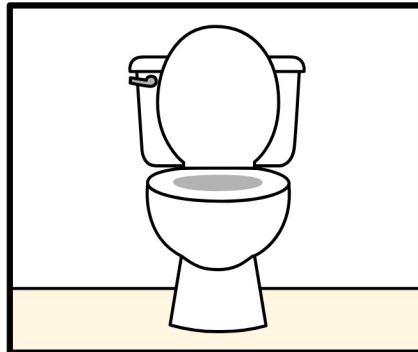
I will need to arrive at school by 8:00am and meet my teacher at my classroom.

My recess, lunch and drink bottle need to be in a small bag. I will give this to my teacher, it will go into a tub.

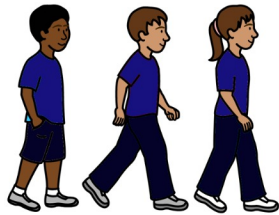


I can go to the toilet with a friend at school before we get on the bus.

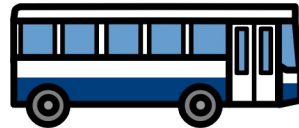


After doing the roll, I will walk quietly to the bus with my teacher and class. The bus will be waiting for us outside the school. We will go through the gate near Room 50.

As we get on the bus, a teacher will count how many students get on. We will then travel by bus to Brownes Dairy.



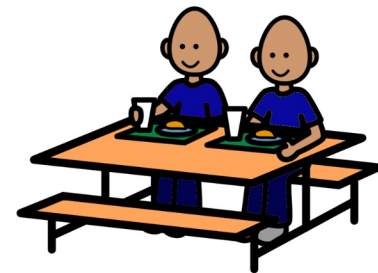

When the bus arrives at Brownes Dairy, we will tour the factory. I will need to listen quietly to the tour guide.

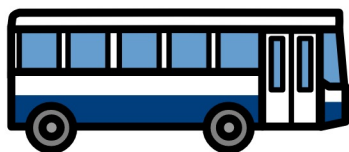


At Brownes Dairy, we will get to taste yoghurt, tour the factory and watch a cow being milked.

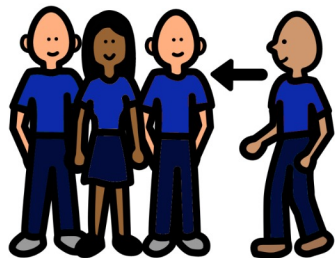
After lunch, it will be time to get on the bus again. We will travel to Bunnings. This will be a quick trip.

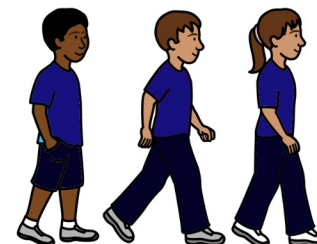

I will complete two activities with my group. It is important that I listen to the adult helper and stay with my group.

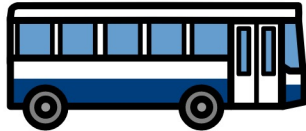


I can ask the adult helper or my teacher if I have a question.
